

Alexander Leonidovich BESEDIN

Alexander L. Besedin was born in 1948, 18 July in Kirovograd (USSR).

In 1966 he graduated with the Silver Medal from mathematical class of 58th school in Tula.

In 1972 he graduated magna cum laude from the Automatic Control Systems Department of Tula Polytechnic Institute, where he received the academic degree of a Candidate of technical sciences (1978).

In 1981 he has been awarded with the Honorary Certificate of the MACHPROM Presidium, in 1982 – with the badge «Inventor of the USSR», in 1983 he received the academic title of an assistant professor.

In 1983-84 he was trained at the Natural Sciences Department of Olomouc University (Czech Republic), he was awarded with the Silver Medal of Olomouc University and the Honorary badge of Czech-Soviet friendship.

In 1984 he has been awarded with the Honorary Diploma of the International Congress ACADEMIA FILM.

In 1985 he became a holder of Sergey Mosin Prize.

In 1985 he founded and headed one of the first in the USSR Informatics Department in Far East State University. He was initiator of the launching, author and presenter of the scientific and popular TV program cycle «Informatics for Everybody» on the Far East State TV.

In 1986 at the Research Institute of Management Systems he headed the work on the design of the information computerized network of the USSR State Procurement Committee.

In 1989 he has been awarded with the Silver Medal of the USSR VDNH - National Economy Achievements Exhibition.

Since 1990 he has been actively working in the following areas: contemporary organizations management and reformation of their work allowing for balanced stable regions development; design of new generation learning organizations - biocybercorporations; design of corporate learning and consulting systems; revival of small Russian towns based on Magnetic Educational Centers; business education (management of projects of launching in Russia MBA and BBA programs; creation of 18 author's courses in adult learning system in accordance with the concept of UNESCO).

In 1996 A.L. Besedin's activity in the business education sphere has been awarded with the Honorary Certificate of the International Public Development Academy (as a scientist and an organizer for the launching of the new type educational organizations in Russia and creation of author's courses in modern management).

In 1999 conception of cyber-corporate management based on Flexible Integrative Systems of Consulting and Corporate Learning, created by Alexander Besedin, was recognized as an innovation in the Certificate issued by the Academy of the Peoples of the World «ELITE».

Besides, during the period 1990-2000 his activity has been awarded with the Certificate of the Russian Project Management Association SOVNET (1996), the Certificate of the Heinz Nixdorf Foundation Programme (1997), the Honorary Diploma of the Intergovernmental TV&Radio Company "MIR" (1998).

He received the honorary degrees Doctor of Philosophy (Ph. D., 1998), Doctor of Public Creation (2000), Doctor of Education (2000) and honorary titles Grand Master of International Interacademical Union (Canada, 1998) and Full Professor of International Interacademical Union for Support of Science and Promotion of Researcher Trainings (IIU, 1999).

In 1997 A.L. Besedin has been elected an active member of the International Academy of Energyinformative Sciences, in 2005 – an active member of the International Informatization Academy.

In 2005 he became a Laureate of the International Competition "Elite of the Informationologists of the World". His activity has been awarded with the High International Order (2006) and High International Medal (2007) "For Faithful Promotion of Information Community".

In 2007 he became a holder of Sergey Mosin Prize in second time.

In 2007 A.L. Besedin successfully defended the dissertation “Industrial enterprises restructuring: the theory and methodology”. He received the academic degree of a Doctor of Economics.

In 2008 A.L. Besedin has been decorated with the High International Order “For Outstanding Merits in Informationology”.
